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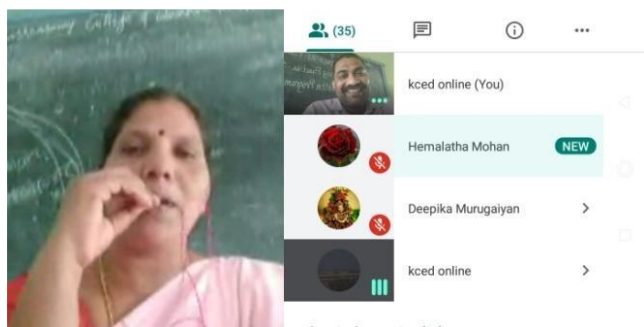
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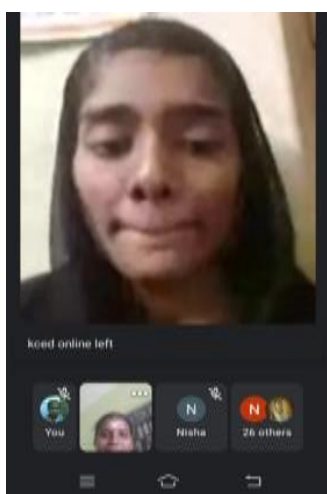
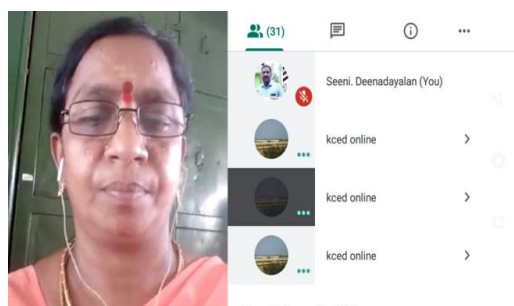

**National Integration Week**

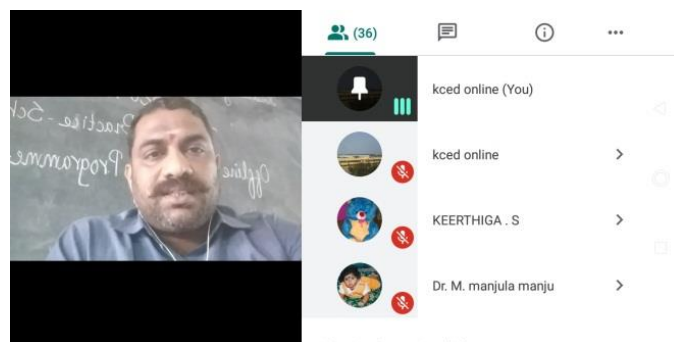


The “National Integration Week” celebration was organized on 11<sup>th</sup> January 2021 through online mode. A variety of programmes were arranged.

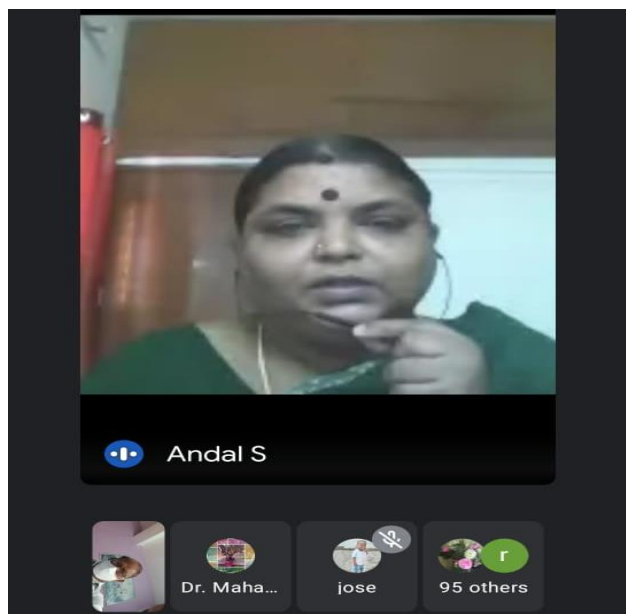
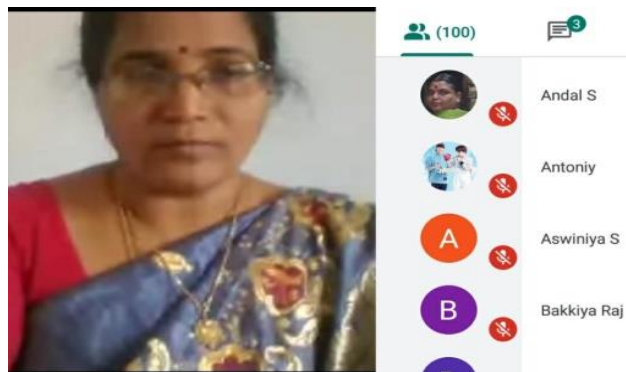
### Online Webinars and Workshop

National Level Webinar On "Digital Well Being For Online Learning And Teaching" - 4<sup>th</sup> May, 2021, Organized by IQAC of the College.

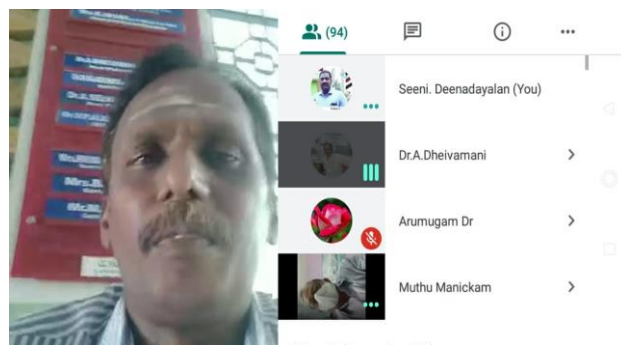
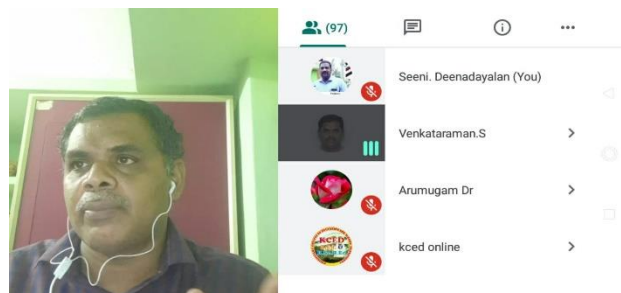
Three one day Webinars and One Online Workshop were organized in the college on various days in different themes.

A national level webinar on "Digital Well-being for online learning and teaching" was organized by IQAC of the college on 4<sup>th</sup> May 2021. COVID-19 Pandemic has drastically changed human life, particularly students and teachers' and the day-to-day lives. In this quarantine situation, most of the learning, teaching and assessments are through online modes.
