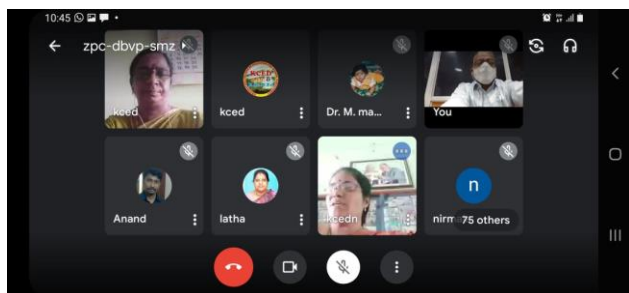

“Adapting inevitable changes in education sector”

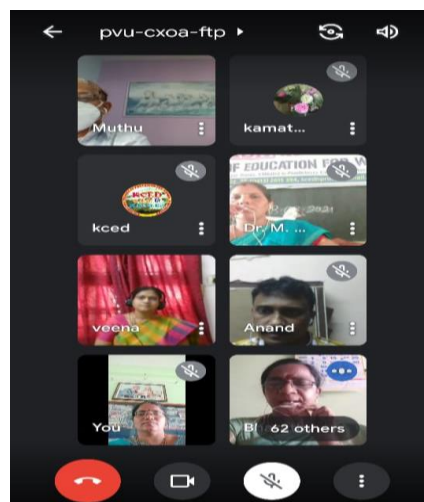

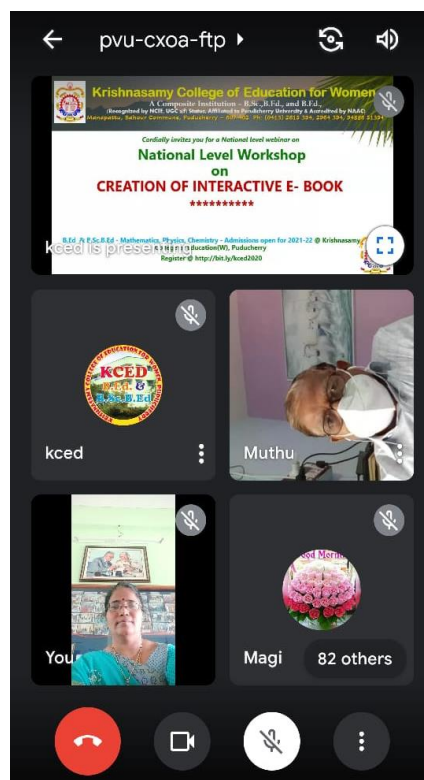
NATIONAL LEVEL WORKSHOP (ONLINE)

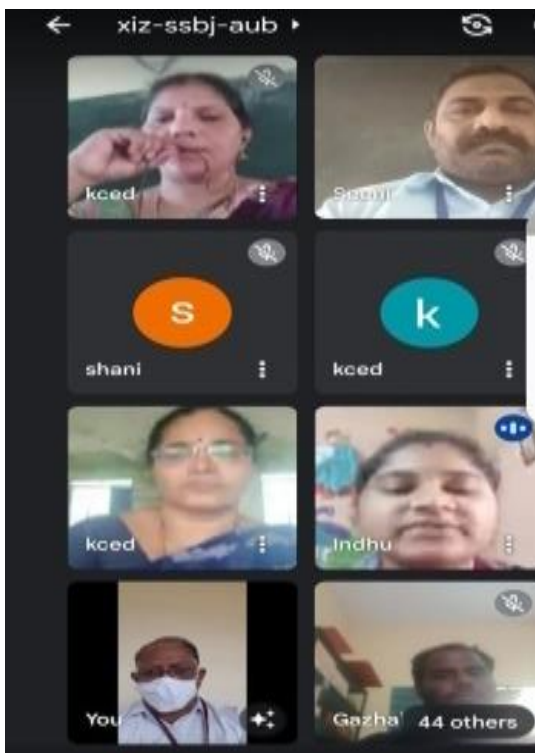


National Education Day
