PSYCHOLOGY LABORATORY

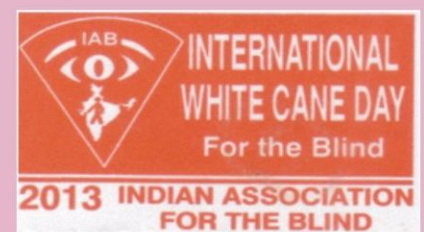

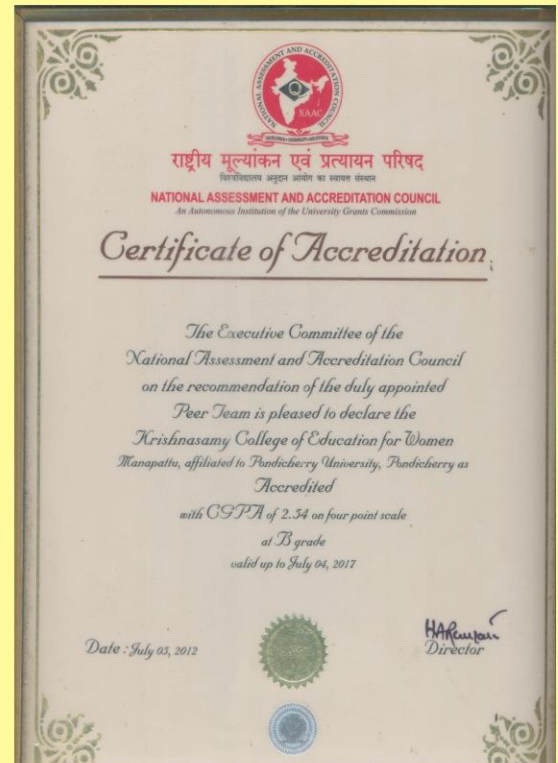
CERTIFICATE OF ACCREDITATION
