## ABOUT THE COLLEGE

Krishnasamy College of Education for Women (KCEdn) was established in the academic year 2005-2006 to cater the needs of Teacher Education for Women. The college has been providing education, especially for down trodden, socially and economically backward women. KCED is situated in the south edge of French tradition based Union territory of Puducherry. It is an eight acre campus in the midst of rural village named as Manapattu of the Bahour Commune. It is a hop away from the south gate way of Puducherry and it is on the East Coast Road. The Institution has been dedicating itself to the service of society by educating teachers and preparing professional educators at the secondary level for the last 18 years. The College is affiliated to the University of Pondicherry, recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education and accredited by NAAC & 2f status from UGC.

In two year B.Ed., there are six departments namely Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Bio-science and Social Science. The 4 year B.Sc., B.Ed. integrated program, was introduced for HSC competed students from the academic year 2020-21. It constitutes of three departments namely Mathematics, Physics, and Chemistry. Most of the faculty members have completed Ph.D.,/NET with ten years of experience in this institution. The faculty members are well trained for curriculum construction and transactions, project and extension activities. The Vision of the College is to emerge as a Centre of Excellence in Teacher Education. The College has a good record of excellence and reputation and has a strong commitment to address to the needs arising from a dynamic and rapidly changing world. From the academic year 2020-21 the college is converted as a composite institution offering 2 year B.Ed. and 4 year B.sc B.Ed. programme. At present the college is planning to convert as a multidisciplinary intuition as per the requirements of NEP 2020.

The new excellent and rich curriculum of the Pondicherry University is being transacted with well-equipped curricular laboratories and ICT and other resource centers including library, the sports facilities and hostel facilities are available separately for women. Every year National Seminar and Webinar are conducted.
