About the college

Krishnasamy College of Education for Women (KCEd) was established in the academic year 2005-2006 to cater to the needs of Teacher Education for Women. This college provides education, especially for down trodden, socially and economically backward women.

KCED is situated in the south edge of French tradition based Union territory of Puducherry. It is in the midst of rural village named as Manapattu of the Bahour Commune. It is a hop away from the south gate way of Puducherry and it is on the East Coast Road. The Institution has dedicated itself to the service of society by educating teachers and preparing professional educators at the secondary level for last ten years.

The College is affiliated to the University of Pondicherry, recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education and accredited by NAAC. It is one of the best Institutions under the umbrella of the prestigious Sri Subbulakshmi Krishnasamy Reddiar Educational Trust in Cuddalore.

There are six departments namely Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Bio-science and Social Science. Totally we have 10 teaching staff and 8 non-teaching

The Krishnasamy College of Education organized its 10th batch inaugural function on 18th Aug 2014. This function was attended by the new batch of students along with parents and staff members.

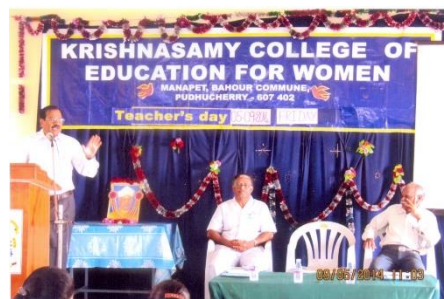

Special Training on Green School, Home Gardening and Organic Vegetable Production

The social activist cum ward member Mr.S. Parthiban, an agriculturist was invited on 23.09.2014 to conduct a programme on "Green School, Home Gardening and Organic Vegetable Production" for the purpose to generate home gardening.



In that training session, he taught how to plough the land in the home atmosphere and the method of seeding.



In addition to the above, he taught roof cultivation also. In the absence of gardening land, he suggested the students to cultivate in pot or in polythene bag by putting the saw of coconut fibre. Apart from the cultivation he taught, how to prepare natural pesticides "Panchakaviya" and the method and durational gap of spraying the pesticides on the plants.

Finally, he distributed a pocket of ten different seeds to all the students and then he seeded the variety of seeds in the model garden of the college campus.

The principal, KCEDN gave the presidential address to the programme and the vote of thanks was proposed by

In each school, one leader was selected for their own Best performance.
