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About the college

Krishnasamy College of Education for Women (KCEd) was established in the academic year 2005-2006 to cater to the needs of Teacher Education for Women. This college provides education, especially for down trodden, socially and economically backward women.

KCED is situated in the south edge of French tradition based Union territory of Puducherry. It is in the midst of rural village named as Manapattu of the Bahour Commune. It is a hop away from the south gate way of Puducherry and it is on the East Coast Road. Model Examinations I, II & III

The I and II Model Exams were conducted from 16-02-2015 to 18-02-2015 and 20-04-2015 to 22-04-2015 for 40 marks and time allotment was one and half hours. It was containing the 5 units each from the syllabus. The III Model Examination was from 4-5-2015
