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About the college

Krishnasamy College of Education for Women (KCED) was established in the academic year 2005-2006 to cater to the needs of Teacher Education for Women. This college provides education, especially for down trodden, socially and economically backward women.

KCED is situated in the south edge of French tradition-based Union territory of Puducherry. It is amid rural village named as Manapattu of the Bahour Commune. It is a hop away from the south gate way of Puducherry and it is on the East Coast Road. The Institution has dedicated itself to the service of society by educating teachers and preparing professional educators at the secondary level for last fourteen-years.

The College is affiliated to the University of Pondicherry, recognized by the National Council for Teacher Education and accredited by NAAC. It is one of the best Institutions under the umbrella of the Krishnasamy Group of Institutions in Cuddalore and Puducherry.

There are six departments namely Tamil, English, Mathematics, Physical Science, Bio-science and Social Science. We have sufficient teaching and non-teaching staff members. All the teaching faculties have completed Ph.D. or / and NET qualification. Most of the faculty members have completed ten years of experience in this institution. The Vision of the College is to emerge as a Centre of Excellence in Teacher Education.

The College has a good record of excellence and reputation and has a strong commitment to address to the needs arising from a dynamic and rapidly changing society.
