21.01.2020- SWACHHTA PAKHWADA – Menstrual Hygiene Management Awareness Programme



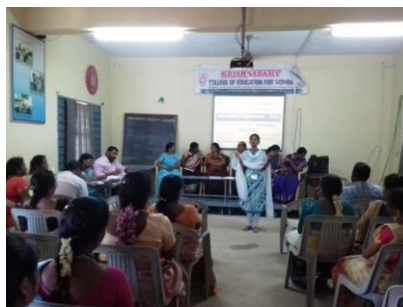
